REGISTRATION IS OPEN: Class sizes are limited to 12 due to COVID-19.

CAMP COSTS: All costs include supplies and are non-refundable.

Wednesday - Meditative Art Through the Senses



CAMP LOCATIONS: The classes are held at the Kemper Center lakefront campus: 6501 3rd Avenue, Kenosha. Since the weeks are limited to 12 campers, the classes will all be in the Faulkner Building, in rain or shine.
