TIMELINE (Please note that all dates below are subject to change)

- **Tuesday-Friday, October 19-22**
Drop off work at the Anderson Arts Center (6603 Third Avenue, Kenosha, WI) between 9:00am and 4:00pm. Prior arrangements must be made with the Administrator by emailing rena@andersonartscenter.com or calling (262) 653-0481.
- **Tuesday-Friday October 26-29**
Work judged.
- **Friday, October 29**
Artists will be notified by this date and arrangements made for pick up of work not juried into the Exhibition.
- **Sunday, November 21**
Opening Reception held from 1:00-4:00pm. Depending on COVID-19, all participating artists are encouraged to attend. Prizes will be awarded during the Reception.
- **Sunday, January 9, 2021**
Exhibition concludes. Artists should make arrangements to pick up work the following week, Tuesday-Friday, January 11-14, between 9:00am and 4:00pm. Work not picked up during that week may be subject to a \$1 per piece, per day, storage fee.

ELIGIBILITY & RESTRICTIONS

Work submitted should not have been shown at the Anderson Arts Center before and should have been produced within the last three years. Eligible work can be in any media executed by artists 18 years or older. Work on paper must be framed and wired for hanging unless otherwise stipulated by the artist. Sawtooth hangers are not allowed. Frames must have felt or fabric pads on the backs of each corner to avoid scratching or damaging the walls when hanging. Wall pieces must be limited to 50 pounds per piece. Work on paper should be covered with glass or Plexiglass. Plexiglass is recommended. The Anderson Arts Center will not be responsible for glass breakage. The Anderson Arts Center reserves the right at all times to exclude any work that presents complex exhibition problems.

ENTRY

Two works per artist may be submitted. All work must be accompanied by entry labels and entry fee. A \$20.00 non-refundable entry fee is required. Cash, credit, and checks accepted. Make check payable to the Anderson Arts Center.

ENTRY LABEL

Please use the label format provided within this Prospectus. Attach the label with string to wire on the left hand side back of each piece of art work being submitted.

AGREEMENT

Submission of work indicates acceptance of all conditions here set forth. No work may be removed for the duration of the show. No packing materials may be stored at the Anderson Arts Center. Works are insured while on the premises of the Anderson Arts Center. Prices must be consistent with work sold elsewhere and may not be changed once a piece has been accepted for exhibition. The gallery commission is 40% of the selling price.
